PROCEDURE TO APPLY FOR THE INSIDE WIREMAN ELECTRICAL APRENTICESHIP

Position: The Inside Wireman Electrical Apprenticeship is a five-year training program that consists of 8,000 hours of paid on-the-job training, in addition to 900 hours of classroom instruction over 5 years. Classes are held two separate weeks in the Fall semester and two separate weeks in the Spring semester at our Electrical Training Center in Santa Rosa. Apprentices are paid while they work, with wages starting at 40% percent of Journeyman Electrician wage with an increase of 5% every six months, or every 1,000 hours worked. Apprentices receive health benefits- medical, dental & vision once the apprentice has worked 500 hours. Apprentices begin earning a pension upon completion of their first year.

Duties: The Apprentice Electrician works directly under the supervision of a State certified Journeymen Inside Wireman Electrician in installing or maintaining a variety of approved wiring methods for distribution of electrical light, heat, power, radio and signaling utilization systems in existing or new buildings under construction of residential, commercial and industrial occupancies; including street and highway lighting, traffic signal and other outdoor above and below grade installations.

Physical requirements: All applicants must possess the ability to perform the work of the trade.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Be 17 ½ years old to apply and 18 years old to enter apprenticeship.
- Have graduated from high school or passed the GED or an equivalent.
- Have completed one full year (2 semesters) of high school algebra with a grade of "C" or better, or one semester of a college level algebra course with a "C" or better, or completed the NJATC Online Tech math course: www.electricaltrainingalliance.org/learning/onlinetechmath
- Provide an official sealed transcript showing courses and grades from High School and/or College. All Transcripts must be turned in on the date you make the application, no exceptions.
- Pre-employment drug testing will be required before an applicant is put to work
