PROCEDURE TO APPLY FOR THE RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN ELECTRICAL APTRENTICESHIP

Position: The Residential Wireman Electrical Apprenticeship is a 3-year training program that consists of 4,800 hours of paid on-the-job training, in addition to 480 hours of classroom instruction over the 3 years. Classes will be held two nights a week at our Electrical Training Center in Santa Rosa. Apprentices are paid while they work and learn. Current starting pay is 50% of Journeyman rate with increases every 800 hours worked and satisfactory completion of the appropriate school year.

Duties: The Residential Wiremen installs the systems that distribute power from the point of entry in a building to the equipment within a building that uses that power. The difference between the Inside Wireman and the Residential Wireman is that, while the Inside Wireman is performing electrical work in commercial and industrial facilities, the Residential Wireman is performing and maintaining the electrical systems in homes and other types of residential installations.

Physical requirements: All applicants must possess the ability to perform the work of the trade.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Be 17 ½ years old to apply and 18 years old to enter apprenticeship.
- Have graduated from high school or passed the GED or an equivalent.
- Have completed one full year (2 semesters) of high school algebra with a grade of "C" or better, or one semester of a college level algebra course with a "C" or better, or completed the NJATC Online Tech math course: www.electricaltrainingalliance.org/learning/onlinetechmath
- Provide an official sealed transcript showing courses and grades from High School and/or College. All Transcripts must be turned in on the date you make the application, no exceptions.
- Pre-employment drug testing will be required before an applicant is put to work
